CUIL100 – UX/UI Design Leadership Essentials Micro-Certificate

Bridge the gap between design execution and strategic leadership.

This micro-certificate builds the core capabilities needed to lead projects, manage relationships, and navigate emerging trends in digital design. Students will learn how to structure and oversee design work, communicate value to clients and stakeholders, and apply forward-looking tools and concepts such as generative AI and spatial design to their practice.

Designed for working professionals, this program offers a future-focused toolkit for product designers, freelancers, and emerging team leads preparing to take on more strategic, leadership-aligned roles.

You will learn to:

- Manage design projects successfully, from planning to execution, including budget and risk management

COURSES

Develop key skills in scheduling, risk management, team coordination, and translating user needs into clear, actionable design tasks.

Strengthen your business skills to support a sustainable and impactful design career. This course covers key areas like business models, budgeting, branding, and working with clients plus legal considerations like contracts, IP, and ethical practices. Learn how to promote your value, run effective sessions, and navigate the realities of freelance or team-based design work with confidence.

CUIL 103 Design Innovation & Emerging Tech

Explore how emerging technologies are reshaping UX/UI design. This course examines concepts like Zero UI, generative AI, and spatial interfaces, helping you understand both their potential and their limitations. Through critical discussion and practical exploration, you'll develop a future-ready mindset to navigate technological change with creativity, adaptability, and ethical awareness.
